

Planning Team

- Individuals comprised of various skillsets, committed to working 4 to 6 months. Team consists of:
- Event Planner Coordinates fundraisers, beauty drive, and P.A. Cares Send-Off event
- Community Outreach Identifies salons/spas, organizations, and businesses that will collect or donate beauty product
- **Education Liaison** Identifies contacts at the local school district and non-profits that will assist with recruiting girls
- Administrator Assists Chapter Project Manager in maintaining documents, letters, templates, etc.
- **Publicist** Identifies media partners, bloggers, promoters and networking on behalf of the chapter.
- **Connector** Identifies opportunities for additional resources
- All hands-on deck members that assists the Chapter Project Manager and Planning Team with the following:
- Promoting the beauty drive and send-off event
- Collecting product donations
- Attending promotional and fundraising events
- Participating at the Pack-N-Play and P.A. Cares Send-off events
- Decorating, gift bag stuffing, icebreakers, set-up, etc.
